If your enrollment level changes in the first two weeks of the quarter, you don't have to pay back financial aid from state grants or scholarships. These include the Washington College Grant, College Bound Scholarship, and Passport to Career. You won't need to repay what went towards your tuition or what you received directly, but there's still an impact. If you decide not to pay it back, the full amount you got will be taken from your future funding from these sources. You'll also need to submit this form to the Financial Aid Office of Green River College before you can get more funding
