What is SatisfactoryAcademicProgress(SAP)?

All students who apply for financial aid must maintain satisfactory academic progress. Students can establish and maintain satisfactory academic progress by satisfying all of the following three criteria:

- 1. Quality—Students must maintain a minimum grade pto inverage (GPA) of 2.0 each quarter. Students are also required to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 at the end of the second academic year (six quarters) and thereafter regardless of enrollment level. Certificate programs must maintain a cumulative 2.0 PA consistent with the requirements for graduation.
